**Jeremy A. Cecil DOB 08/05/90**

The Burlington Police Department received information from the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children that a resident within our community was in possession of child pornography. Investigators were able to identify Jeremy A. Cecil as the suspect.

On May 24, 2022 the Burlington Police Department's Detective Bureau executed a search warrant on Cecil's residence in the 200 block of Schemmer Street. Several items of evidentiary value were seized for forensic examination. Cecil was taken into custody, interviewed, and transported to the Racine County Jail.

Jeremy Cecil remains in custody and was charged in Racine County Circuit Court with the following charges:

- 12 counts Possession of Child Pornography with a bond of \$25,000

This is an active investigation.

The Burlington Police Department is committed to working in partnership with organizations such as the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children to assist us in ensuring the safety of our residents.
